



Erato Seaside Hotel - Environmental Policy - 10 March 2025

The management of Erato Seaside Hotel recognizes the paramount importance of environmental preservation and is firmly committed to a path of sustainable development. We are dedicated to conducting our operations in a manner that mitigates adverse environmental effects, in alignment with the principles and requirements set forth by the Travelife standard.

Within this framework, our management establishes annual environmental objectives. These objectives are subject to regular review, with the possibility of new objectives being approved or existing ones adjusted based on our progress and the prevailing conditions within the accommodation industry.

Our objectives encompass the following key areas:

Energy Efficiency: To reduce our energy consumption, we:

- Incorporate renewable energy and energy-saving technologies, such as heat pumps, photovoltaics, and solar panels, into our buildings. Currently, 10% of our annual energy consumption is generated by our photovoltaic system.
- Utilize ONLY low-energy or LED lighting in all public areas and accommodations.
- Equip room balcony doors with sensors to automatically deactivate air conditioning when doors are open.
- Install electronic key card systems in all rooms to cut off power supply when guests remove their key before leaving.
- Use motion detectors to further optimize energy savings in some public areas of our hotel.
- Opt for energy-efficient, eco-friendly equipment. All mini-fridges are energy-efficient.
- Implement solar panels for hot water supply.
- Actively explore and stay updated on alternative energy sources.

Water Conservation: To reduce our water consumption, we:

- Encourage guests to implement linen and towel changes every second day, over 70 % of our guests use their towels for 2 days.
- Encourage guest to be mindful of the environment by using pool towels responsibly as this choice can significantly reduce water and detergent usage.
- Install dual flush toilets in guest bathrooms and public facilities.
- Select water-saving equipment and fixtures.

Waste Reduction: To minimize the waste sent to landfills, we:

- Implement a comprehensive waste separation program, including glass, paper, cans, batteries, organic waste, and cooking oils, with a focus on recycling.
- Prioritize equipment and furniture repair and maintenance over replacement whenever feasible.

- Offer water bottle refill stations for our guests to minimize the use of single use plastic bottles.

Chemical Management: To minimize the use of potentially harmful chemicals, we:

- Use biodegradable and environmentally-friendly cleaning products whenever possible.
- Procure products made from recycled materials or those that are recyclable, non-harmful, biodegradable, and non-toxic wherever feasible.

In addition to these specific objectives, our policy commits us to:

- Monitor and comply with environmental legislation relevant to our activities.
- Refrain from engaging in any activities detrimental to local wildlife, thereby safeguarding biodiversity and ecosystems.
- Allocate necessary resources to continually enhance our environmental performance.
- Provide ongoing training and education to our staff, encouraging their active involvement, both individually and as a team, in achieving our environmental goals.
- Foster open dialogue and transparent communication with the local community and other stakeholders, maintaining a spirit of genuine mutual respect.
- Hold the Green Key Award certification, a recognition of our commitment to sustainable practices
- Conduct systematic investigations to identify the root causes of issues and weaknesses, taking corrective actions to prevent their recurrence.

Both the management and all employees of Erato Seaside Hotel operate in accordance with this policy, with commitment to environmental protection. We cordially invite our customers, suppliers, and all our partners to embrace our current policy and join us in supporting our endeavors to minimize the environmental impact of our operations.
